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GLOSSARY OF OUR WINE RARITIES

Explore a selection of unique wines in our bistro, carefully curated by our sommelier team.

Our glossary provides you with insight into the world of forgotten grape varieties that diversify our Alpine region and its surroundings areas.

Altesse

Old white variety that is known since the 13th century, primarily cultivated in the Savoy region of France and partly in Switzerland. It yields complex wines with fruity aromas of peach, citrus fruits, and blossoms. It is often characterized by freshness, elegance, and finesse and can age for a long time.

Blauer Wildbacher

Ancient Austrian variety, a direct descendant (mutation) of the original Heunisch grape variety. It is also closely related to the Austrian Blaufränkisch. It combines a robust structure and lively acidity with fruity-fresh aromas and spiced notes. In Styria, it is often used for rosé known as 'Schilcher'.

Blatterle

Extremely old variety cultivated in the Eisack Valley of South Tyrol, now only grown on 1.6 hectares. Its genetic origin is unknown. The name (also called Platterle) comes from the slightly flattened shape of the grapes (platt = German for flat). The wine offers aromas of green apple, ivy, muscat, and lilac, while on the palate it is often light yet creamy, with a fine tannic texture.

Completer

Swiss Icon! Ancient white grape variety from Grisons. Documented since the early 14th century. The name originates from the evening prayer of the monks of the Cathedral Chapter of Chur (Completorium). Only about 5 hectares cultivated, but rising in popularity, despite being very susceptible to disease that results in very low yields. It produces full-bodied wines with pronounced acidity, capable of long aging. Often aged oxidatively or in the style of a late harvest with residual sweetness.

Cornalin

Considered the best of the red grape varieties in Valais. Sensitive in production, it was nearly abandoned but is now cultivated on 146 hectares. It produces dark, cherry-red wines with violet reflections, being powerful yet very finely structured. Black cherries and cloves often define its flavor profile.

Durize

Ancient red rarity from Valais, its genetic relationship was found in the Aosta Valley. Only 0.65 hectares remain. It produces full-bodied, charming red wines with a fresh acidity.

Gringet

A white rarity from the Savoy Alps, with only 15 hectares remaining. Its genetic origins are not quite clear, although it's often considered a clone of Savagnin or Traminer. A late-ripening grape, it offers a floral aroma, while on the palate it evokes dried apples and yellow plums.

Grosse Arvine

Likely a natural cross between Rèze and an unknown variety. It was once one of the most widely cultivated varieties in Valais, but almost disappeared in the 1980s. Rediscovered and cultivated by Olivier Pittet, who found four old vines in his vineyard. It produces full-bodied, fragrant, long-lasting white wines.

Heida or Païen

Technically, it is the white variety Savagnin from the French Jura. It has been at home in the Upper Valais since the 16th century. Thrives well in high altitudes, in up to over 1,100 meters. It favors sunny slopes and classic dry-stone walls. It achieves ripeness with high sugar contents, making it suitable for sweet wines, but mostly vinified dry into full-bodied wines.

Himbertscha

A white rarity, its name comes from the Valaisan dialect word "im Bercla" - in the pergola. Nearly extinct in 1970, then revitalized by Joseph Marie Chanton. Likely a natural cross between Humagne Blanche and Muscat. It is described as having grassy notes of moss, combined with hints of nuts, lemon balm, but also mango.

Humagne Blanche

A white rarity from Valais, cultivated on just under 30 hectares. This wine, which often has the scent of linden blossoms and is rich in iron, was believed to have healing and strengthening powers. Hence, it's also called postnatal or midwife's wine. Even today, in Valais, it's customary to gift a bottle of Humagne Blanche to a new mother.

Humagne Rouge

Originally from the Aosta Valley, it's a natural cross between Cornalin and an unknown variety. A challenging red grape variety to cultivate, it ripens later than all other Valaisan varieties. Hence, it's also called "Höllenstein" (Hell Wine). It produces robust, tannic wines with flavors of dark berries, undergrowth, and spices like pepper and cloves.

Jacquère

An indigenous variety exclusively found in the French Alpine region of Savoy, where it is the dominant white grape variety. Fresh, often with grassy notes, hints of lemon zest, and good acidity, hence it's also called "fraîcheur alpine" - Alpine freshness.

Lafnetscha

A white rarity from the Upper Valais, whose wine smells of nectarine, apples, but also chamomile and elderflower. According to DNA analysis, it's a natural cross between Humagne Blanc and Completer. Only 2.7 hectares are cultivated. Due to its pronounced acidity, it requires a long aging process. This acidity also gives the grape variety its name, as the recommendation "laff's nid schah" in Valais-german suggests, not to drink these wines when too young.

Lagrein

Indigenous South Tyrolean variety, known since the 14th century. A natural cross between Vernatsch and Teroldego. It produces robust, dark characterized wines with a fine, dense tannin structure. It has good aging potential and responds well to aging in wood.

Malvasia Istriana

Aromatic, excellent white grape variety with limited distribution in Northern Italy, Slovenia, and Croatia. Presumably of Greek origin, like many other varieties that arrived in Northern Italy and Istria via sea and land routes. It produces expressive wines with floral notes, citrus fruits, and herbal aromas.

Mondeuse

A red, indigenous variety from Savoy France, cultivated on approximately 300 hectares. There are also small plantings in Switzerland. Known for its robust tannins, fruity aromas of dark berries, black pepper, and other spices. Its genetics are not definitively clarified, but it has good structure and can gain complexity with some aging. In Savoy, Mondeuse is often called "le petit Syrah".

Petit-Rouge

Old, rare specialty that has been preserved in the Aosta Valley on just under 60 hectares, with a decreasing trend. A late-ripening variety known for producing dark purple, spicy wines with a pronounced blackcurrant note, soft tannins, and well-balanced acidity.

Poulsard

A red rarity from the French Jura. In the AOC Arbois Pupillin, it's also called Ploussard. This variety has low pigmentation with large berries, resulting in very light red wines. The delicately scented, floral, and light-bodied red wines excite not only natural wine enthusiasts, even though it is thanks to them, that Poulsard has undergone a renaissance in the last twenty years.

Räuschling

A rare variety from Zurich, cultivated on only 25 hectares. Known since the 15th century. It produces wines with pronounced acidity, lively, mineral-dry characteristics, with the potential to age, but it's mostly consumed young. The name comes from the large leaves of the vine that tend to rustle in the wind (Rauschen = German for rustle)

Savagnin

In Switzerland, it's also known as Heida or Païen. It's an important white variety in the French Jura. Primarily known for oxidative wines like Vin Jaune, but also often used in Crémant du Jura and vinified as a dry white wine. It produces expressive, robust, and long-lived wines.

Teran

The name for the red variety Refosco when it grows on Terra Rossa soils in the Slovenian, Italian, or Croatian Karst near the city of Trieste. Only the greatest talents manage to tame this very late-ripening, tricky variety. When successful, they produce robust, characterful wines with strong tannins, intensely flavored with dark cherries, blueberries, herbs, and oriental spices.

Teroldego

A South Tyrolean specialty, predominantly found in Trentino. It's related to Pinot Noir as well as the southern French Dureza. It's a parent for Lagrein and Marzemino. Formerly overlooked, but thanks to winemaker Elisabetta Foradori and her Granato, it has regained new fame. Dark wines with gentle tannins, reminiscent of tar, ink, black cherries, and herbs.

Vitovska

A white rarity, covering 51 hectares, primarily found in the Slovenian Karst. In the right hands, it produces complex, straw-yellow, textured white and orange wines with a lot of body, pleasant acidity, and good aging potential. Aromas of hay, pears, quinces, and apricots.
